Personal Electronic Device Policy

With the increased versatility, popularity, and usage of personal electronic devices, an ever-growing number of teenagers possess and regularly use cell phones, Ipods, and other media devices. Please note that any such items found in the possession of a camper during his/her stay at camp will be confiscated and secured in the office until the camper's departure date. This policy prohibits possession of any type of personal electronic device capable of storing and/or playing recorded music, video, or other media files. This includes personal computers. Digital cameras are allowable, and encouraged.


If you are arriving by plane, we encourage you to bring a cell phone in order to communicate with us as you arrive. Please inform us of the phone number prior to your arrival date. Your phone will then be stored in the office until the day of your departure. Please bring the charger as well, so the battery can be fully charged in preparation for your flight home.

Please understand that we do not consider these items inherently evil or dangerous. However, in light of our goal for each camper to have the opportunity to be removed from the pressure of the world and thus to have a proper atmosphere in which to concentrate on musical excellence and Christian commitment, we must insist on strict adherence to this policy. Thank you for your understanding and for your compliance in Christian love and humility.

Key Deposit Required!

Due to the cost of lost key replacement, we require a \$25 cash deposit for each dorm key issued. This deposit will be collected at registration and will be refunded upon checkout when the key is returned. If the key is not returned, the deposit will be transferred to Houghton College to pay for replacing the key and/or changing the lock if deemed necessary. We cannot accept checks or credit cards for this deposit, so please come prepared with cash.

This deposit is required of all Csehy campers, counselors, staff, faculty, and dependents with no exceptions. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
